## 1 Information

Username and passwords are case-sensitive. If you try to [login](#) to your CVS after a new installation, restart your CVS and wait a few minutes.

## 2 Unix/Linux

Unix- or BSD-based systems are always configured with the standard user **root** or **cloud** and the password shown in the client area.

If SSH-Key-based authentication is selected the root account is disabled and it's only possible to [login](#) with the cloud user instead with a valid SSH key.

## 3 BSD

BSD-based systems are always configured with the standard user "**freebsd**" and the password shown in the client area.

## 4 Windows

Windows-based systems are configured with the user name **Admin** or **Administrator** (Server Version) and the password shown in the client area.

The IPv4 address is set automatically during installation. Access via Microsoft® Remote Desktop is also activated.
